MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA) placed eighth in the WCHA regular season standings. In first round play of the WCHA play-offs last year, the Huskies were eliminated in two games at Minnesota Duluth on March 11-12...SCSU received votes in the final USCHO.com Division I national poll of the 2010-11 season.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current national rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - Received votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: did not receive votes...SCSU earned a 7th place ranking in the 2011-12 WCHA preseason media poll and WCHA coaches' preseason poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM/103.3 FM. The show will broadcast live from the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud. Fans are encouraged to attend this show live at the Green Mill and admission is FREE. You can also listen to the show live on the web at www.knsi1450.com



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.knsi1450.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) in 2011-12. KVSC's crew will be led by sports directors Dave Overlund and Zack Fisch.

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (St. Cloud Charter Cable Channel 87 in stunning digital). A select number of home games are slated to be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2011-12. Jim Rich and Tom Saterdalen will be making the call from the NHC this season.

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2011-12, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by seventh-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include five-year veteran Mike Gibbons and second-year coach Steve Johnson and first-year volunteer goalie coach Dave Rogalski. Matt Chapman will serve as the team's coordinator of hockey and video operations and Jeremiah Minkel is back once again as the team's equipment manager in 2011-12.

THE NATIONAL: St. Cloud State University will join the National Collegiate Hockey Conference in 2013-14. The Huskies accepted the invitation to join The National on Sept. 22, and they will join Colorado College, University of Denver, University of Minnesota Duluth, University of Nebraska Omaha, Miami University, University of North Dakota and Western Michigan as members of the new league. SCSU will remain as a member of the WCHA until the 2013-14 season. The Huskies became an NCAA Division I affiliate in 1987-88 and they joined the WCHA in 1990-91.

TOUGH SCHEDULE: SCSU was recognized as having one of the toughest schedules in all of Division I hockey latest season. The upcoming schedule appears to be just as strong. In 2011-12, the Huskies are scheduled to play 11 opponents (out of 15) that are ranked or received votes in this year's preseason polls. Top 10 ranked opponents for SCSU this winter include Denver, North Dakota, Colorado College and Minnesota Duluth. UND is ranked #17 in this week's polls.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST TIME OUT: On the road at #8 Colorado College, the Huskies opened their trip with a tough 3-1 setback on Jan. 13 at the World Arena. SCSU lone goal was posted by Nick Jensen in the 2nd period with helpers from Andrew Prochno and Cory Thorson. This was Jensen's 5th goal of the season. Ryan Faragher charted 23 saves in the game, while Josh Thorimbert had 32 saves for CC...on Jan. 14, the Huskies got back on track with a 5-4 OT victory. Jordy Christian provided the OT game winner for the Huskies at 2:30 of the extra session. SCSU's other goals were marked by Garrett Milan, Jared Festler, Nic Dowd and David Eddy. Faragher was the goalie of record for SCSU with 31 saves in the game. Of note, SCSU outshot the Tigers 70-61 on the weekend.

MILAN MAKES HIS MARK: Freshman forward Garrett Milan, a resident of Whistler, BC, scored his first collegiate goal and point against CC on Jan. 14. On the play, freshman forward Joey Holka also added his first collegiate assist, while the other assist was credited to sophomore defender Kevin Gravel. This was Gravel's first point for the Huskies since he returned from play for Team USA at the World Junior tournament in Canada.

AT THE TOP: Junior forward Ben Hanowski continues to add to his team-leading point total in 2011-12. Hanowski carded an assist on Jan. 14, which pushes his season total 25 points. He also lead the Huskies this season with 12 goals...sophomore defender Nick Jensen had a goal and an assist in the weekend series at CC. He ranks second on the team with 19 points this winter (5g/14a). Of note, the team record for most points by a defenseman in a season is 48 by Bret Hedican in 1990-91.

TWO POINTS: Rookie blueliner Andrew Prochno also enjoyed a two-point series vs. CC, with two assists against the Tigers. Prochno and Hanowski are tied for second on the team this season with 13 assists apiece, while Jensen leads the team with 14 assists... Jared Festler added his 10th goal of the season on Jan. 13, which pushes his career totals to 40 goals, 43 assists and 83 points. Festler and Drew LeBlanc lead the team this season with a +8

TEAM USA: Sophomore defender Kevin Gravel, a draft pick of the Los Angeles Kings, scored a goal for Team USA against Switzerland in the final game of the 2012 World Junior Tournament in Canada. Team USA placed 7th in the tournament. He is the 7th SCSU player to play for Team USA in the World Junior tournament since 1991.

GREAT START: Freshman goalie Ryan Faragher earned his first collegiate shutout (and SCSU's lone shutout of the 2011-12 season) against UND on Oct. 28. Faragher had earned the start at UND due to an injury to junior Mike Lee and he has since played every minute of every game for the Huskies. Faragher has made 18 consecutive starts for the Huskies and he now owns a 2.83 GAA and a .909 save rate this winter.

TEAM CAPTAINS: SCSU team captains for the 2011-12 season will be senior Drew LeBlanc, a forward from Hermantown; junior Ben Hanowski, a forward from Little Falls; and junior Mike Lee, a goalie from Roseau, Minn. Seniors Jordy Christian, Travis Novak and Jared Festler and Sam Zabkowicz will rotate as alternate captains while LeBlanc and Lee recover from early season injuries.

TEAM NOTES: Jordy Christian has been listed as a nominee for the 2012 Hockey Humanitarian Award...the game on Jan. 14 was the Huskies' eighth overtime game in 2011-12. This marked the first OT victory for the Huskies. SCSU is now 1-3-4 in OT games this season... SCSU has outscored its opponents 75 to 73 this season...Cory Thorson joins Prochno and Jensen with an active two-game point streak. Thorson added assists in both games at CC and he now 5g/5a for the Huskies this season... The St. Cloud State men's hockey team will return to the National Hockey Center on Jan. 20-21 for a pair of WCHA games against North Dakota. The Huskies will bring a 9-11-4 overall record into the games, and a 6-7-3 WCHA record into the series...earlier this season, the Huskies split a weekend series against North Dakota in Grand Forks, N.D. On Oct. 28, SCSU posted a big 4-0 shutout win over UND at the Ralph Engelstad Arena and on Oct. 29, the Huskies lost a 3-1 decision at UND.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season seven with the Huskies in 2011-12. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. Motzko has charted an impressive 129-103-33 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional. Last year, Motzko led SCSU to a 15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA record.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by Mike Gibbons, Steve Johnson and Dave Rogalski. SCSU's support staff features equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Hockey and Video Operations Matt Chapman.
